

**Tsui Lam Parent Notice
(2021-02-18)**

Dear Parents,

The Education Bureau announced on 3rd February that after the Chinese New Year holiday, schools may arrange students to attend half-day face-to-face classes, with the number of students limited to a maximum of one-third of the total number of students. After considering the learning needs and health protection of students, school will arrange students to return school according to class levels/classes.

*Notes: 1. On these days of face-to-face classes, no online classes will be conducted for these class levels/classes.

2. The above arrangement is tentatively maintained until Easter holiday.

3. We will review the situation of students returning to school in the first two weeks and adjust the arrangement if necessary.

Students should return to school on time for face-to-face classes and stay home to participate in online classes for the rest of the days. Parents are required to arrange transport for their children, including students who usually travel by school bus. Notes/assignments of the main subjects will be distributed to students upon their return to school in the first week. Parents are advised to remind their children to keep and complete the assignments according to the learning progress of the classes. After-school activities will continue to be conducted online. The school will continue to provide face-to-face/online therapy and counselling services for students in need. Parents will be contacted by class teachers, teacher-in-charge or therapist for further arrangements.

The school will actively prepare the arrangement for the next phase of class resumption according to the development of the epidemic and the latest measures of the Education Bureau. Parents are advised to continue to monitor the health of their children and teach them to maintain good personal hygiene. If you have any enquiries, please contact our school.
